July 2026 has been a watershed month in the history of The Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SGCCI), characterized by historic policy victories and the swift execution of core inauguration commitments. It fills me with immense pride to present ground-level achievements that directly impact your enterprise growth.

During the severe deluge and flood crisis that hit Surat and South Gujarat recently, SGCCI mobilized immediate relief measures. Following the dedicated relief package announced by the Government of Gujarat under the 'Surat Flood Relief Scheme'—which offers a 7% interest subvention on loans up to 30 Lakhs—SGCCI actively coordinated with the District Industries Centre (DIC) and leading bankers to ensure seamless ground-level execution. Furthermore, through our follow-ups, a major waiver was secured allowing official damage assessment certificates issued by SGCCI or trade associations to serve as valid proof in the absence of photos or videos. To continuously safeguard our industrial units during catastrophic emergencies or fire crisis, we officially launched the 'SGCCI Udyog

Sathi 24 * 7' helpline (7211173108). Simultaneously, to catapult enterprises with revenues between 5 Cr to 25 Cr and above 25 Cr into global markets, we operationalized the 'SGCCI Wadhvani Accelerate Pro' and 'Liftoff' frameworks to scale turnovers from 1X to 3X on a zero-equity model.

On the policy front, our high-level representations at the MNRE Ministry in New Delhi successfully secured an ALMM exemption extension up to December 31, 2026, for solar installations. With my official appointment to the State Advisory Committee (SAC) of GERC, the power tariff concerns of our textile and MSME sectors will now be championed at the highest regulatory forum.

From empowering female artisans via the 'Shraavan Business Mela 2026' to mentoring youth on Guru Purnima through the 'Importance of Guru in the Era of Google & AI' seminar, SGCCI stands as an unwavering shield and growth engine for South Gujarat through natural calamities and industrial challenges alike.

Amidst this alarming situation, SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala acted with deep empathy for his team. Before conditions deteriorated further, he granted early leave to all staff members, personally ensuring their safe return home. Yet, determined that Chamber operations should not stall during this critical period, he maintained constant digital command, staying in continuous contact with civic authorities to monitor the evolving situation.

The moment floodwaters began receding, President Ashok Jirawala organized an immediate cleanup to restore office functionality, standing shoulder-to-shoulder with distressed citizens and traders. Without losing a moment, he launched a mission-mode drive to aggregate verified damage metrics from South Gujarat's textile, diamond, and MSME sectors to prepare a strong representation for government intervention.

PART 2: SGCCI LAUNCHES 'MISSION DATA' TO ASSESS INDUSTRIAL DAMAGE

Submerged factories across textile processing, weaving, diamond units, and MSMEs faced severe damage to machinery, raw materials, and finished stock. On July 9,

2026, SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala issued an urgent appeal to all trade associations, stating, “To secure meaningful government relief, possessing structured and official loss data is absolutely vital.”

Under President Ashok Jirawala's guidance, SGCCI issued a standardized format (Unit Name, GST Number, MSME details, Loss Amount, and Evidence Photos) to collect damage metrics directly and via email (dysec@sgcci.in).

PART 3: HISTORIC RELIEF PACKAGE RECALLS THE 2006 'MODI MODEL'

Armed with verified data collected by SGCCI, swift representations led Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and Deputy Chief Minister Harsh Sanghavi to announce a historic rehabilitation package for flood-hit Surat on July 15, 2026.

Welcoming the package, SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala remarked, “In 2006, then Chief Minister Narendra Modi personally directed ground operations to clear sludge and restore power on a war footing. Walking on that exact visionary ‘Modi Model’, Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and Deputy Chief Minister

High-level bankers' meet held at Surat Collectorate; Following SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala's representation, flood-affected traders get major relief in loss documentation.

Accelerating loan approvals under the 'Surat Flood Relief Scheme', a high-level meeting chaired by the General Manager of DIC was convened with regional bankers

at the Surat Collectorate following active representations by SGCCI.

In the presence of SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala and Past President Ashish Gujarati, it was decided that if flood-affected traders lack photo/video evidence of damage, a certificate from SGCCI or recognized trade associations will serve as valid proof.

Harsh Sanghavi have injected fresh vitality into Surat's economy. The government used SGCCI's verified loss data as the bedrock for this package."

Key Highlights of the Package:

Small Vendors: 7,500 for handcart operators, 25,000 for small kiosks, and 50,000 for larger cabins.

Shops & GST Units: 1 Lakh outright cash assistance OR 7% interest subvention on term loans up to 30 Lakhs for 3 years.

Tax Waiver & Khadi Committee: Complete

1-year property tax waiver for flood-affected residential and commercial properties. A High-Level Committee chaired by the Urban Development Principal Secretary has been constituted for permanent Khadi flood prevention.

SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala expressed heartfelt gratitude to the state government on behalf of the entire South Gujarat industrial grid for deploying over 9,000 sanitation workers and disbursing 13.15 Crore in immediate household relief.



SIMPLIFIED RULES & GUIDELINES

Under the scheme, loans up to 30 Lakhs will attract a 7% annual interest subvention for 3 years. Applicants must obtain a bank sanction letter and

submit it to the DIC. The scheme is completely independent of insurance claims. Applicants must attach GSTR-3B returns for April, May, and June 2026.

Spanning an area of 455 square kilometers with a total population of approximately 135,130, this island nation relies heavily on tourism as its economic backbone. Its capital, Victoria, is known as one of the smallest capitals in the world, featuring just 2 traffic signals and easily explorable on foot in a

Unlike most island nations formed by volcanic activity, Seychelles stands out as its islands are uniquely composed of solid granite rocks. On Praslin Island, the native 'Coco de Mer' trees produce the world's largest and heaviest coconuts, weighing up to 30 kilograms each. Over 150,000 giant tortoises inhabit Aldabra Atoll in Seychelles, where Prime Minister Narendra Modi fed leaves to a 194-year-old tortoise named Jonathan during his visit. For Indian travelers, Seychelles conveniently offers a Visa-on-Arrival facility.

INDIAN DIASPORA & CULTURAL SYNCRETISM

People of Indian origin constitute nearly 10% to 11% (~15,200) of the total population in Seychelles. Indians have been part of the island's fabric since the very first settlers arrived in 1770 under French rule. During British governance, traders and skilled artisans migrated from Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, and Pondicherry, establishing deep commercial roots.

Today, Indian conglomerates—particularly from the Patel community such as KRG Group (Kalyanji Kurji Patel), Shreeji Construction (Keshra Mahipa), and Vijay Construction (Valjibhai Patel)—lead major projects across construction, hospitality, and healthcare. Gujarati entrepreneurs command a massive presence across Seychelles' hotels, infrastructure, and retail trade. Cultural ties run deep, with Indian festivals like Navratri, Diwali, and Uttarayan celebrated with great grandeur across the islands.

Detailing laparoscopic advantages, Dr. Mrudul Patel explained that 1 cm keyhole entry points paired with 3D/4K consoles replace traditional 15-20 cm incisions. Because physical trauma is drastically reduced, patients can initiate post-surgery chemotherapy or radiation cycles on schedule without recovery delays. Advanced modalities such as ICG Dye and PIPAC (for Stage-4 peritoneal management) were also highlighted as standard care.

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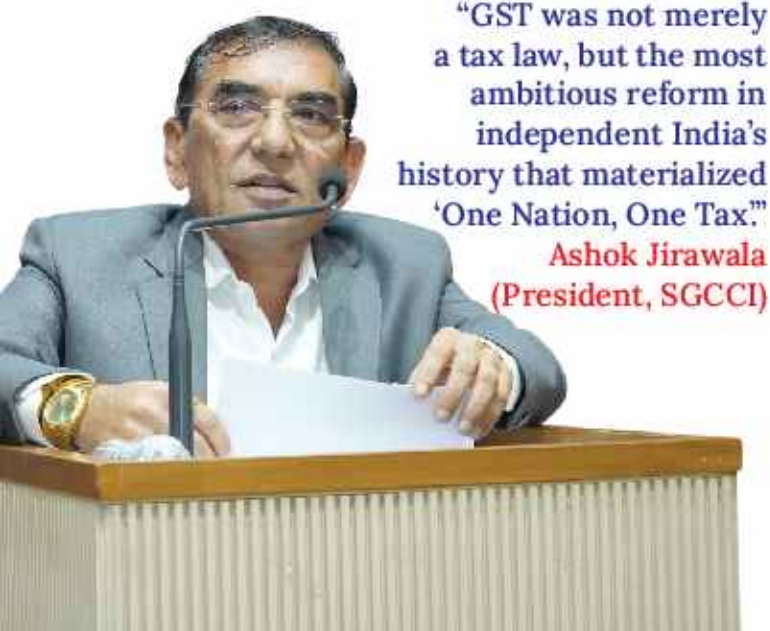

BURNT BY LIGNITE: SURAT INDUSTRY IN DISTRESS!

The Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SGCCI) and SGTPA hold an emergency session with GMDC officials over arbitrary price hikes and severe supply shortages

Addressing severe operational disruptions faced by South Gujarat's textile processing houses and manufacturing units due to lignite supply shortages and price inflation, The Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SGCCI) along with the South Gujarat Textile Processors Association (SGTPA) convened a high-level meeting on Friday, July 3, 2026, at Sarsana.

Initiating the session, SGCCI President Ashok Jirawala delivered the welcome address while leading the industrial delegation to present a resolute case before Neeraj Patel, General Manager (Sales & Marketing - Coal), Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation (GMDC). President Ashok Jirawala explicitly urged GMDC management to adopt an

empathetic, industry-first strategy and resolve the genuine grievances of regional processing houses without delay.

Under his leadership, trade representatives outlined 4 core grievances before the state mining authority:

1. Unprecedented Price Hikes: Demanded an immediate rollback of arbitrary price increases implemented between May and July 2026.

2. Supply Inconsistency: Inability to secure allocated monthly quotas on schedule.

3. Logistical Burden: Diversion of supply from the local Tadkeshwar mine to the distant Bhavnagar facility, driving up freight costs.

4. Artificial Scarcity: Demanded strict monitoring of unauthorized trade practices exploiting open market supply deficits.

DIESEL HIKE & MONSOON WATERLOGGING RESPONSIBLE: GMDC

Responding to the representations, GMDC officials clarified that elevated industrial diesel prices alongside early monsoon waterlogging at the nearby Tadkeshwar pit disrupted extraction and logistics. Reduced local output necessitated supply rerouting and price adjustments. However, GMDC executives assured that industry grievances would be escalated to state and central government levels for an expedited resolution.

The meeting was attended by SGTPA President Jitendrabhai Vakharia, prominent industrialist J. P. Agarwal, Vinod Agarwal, SGCCI Honorary Treasurer Atul Patel, GIDC Committee Chairman Mitul Mehta, and senior SGTPA executive Binay Agarwal.

EXEMPTION EXTENDED TO DECEMBER 31, 2026

Previously, this waiver was valid only until May 31, 2026.

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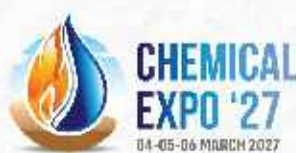
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
